Lee's motion to divest
receiver


The Receiver in this case has failed in complying with his mandatory duties and is now requesting \$82,000 from the courts for manipulating the judicial process. Stephen J. Moriarty and all counsel employed by Stephen J. Moriarty must be divested before the District Court compensates any of the counsel responsible or employed by the counsel responsible that worked on this case.

28 U.S.C. § 754 states, "To maintain exclusive jurisdiction and control over property located in other

judicial districts, however, the "receiver shall, within ten days after the entry of his order of appointment, file copies of the complaint and such order of appointment in the district court for each district in which property is located. The failure to file such copies in any district shall divest the receiver of jurisdiction and control over all such property in that district.". The 10-day time frame was not complied with and the documents that were required to be filed with the Federal Court in Charleston County, South Carolina were not filed.

The Receiver stated several times that it was in his best interests to repay the investors. It is not in the investors interest to see 25% of their money turned over to a Receiver that has repeatedly failed in his duties. The Receiver is to be fair and unbiased in their empowered duties and failed in those duties, also. Relief Defendant Darren Lee respectfully requests that the Court divest the Receiver and his entourage from his duties.


