**ORDER OF DISMISSAL AND DISSOLUTION OF RECEIVERSHIP**

On October 14, 2004, Plaintiff filed a *Petition for Permanent Injunction and other Equitable Relief* against Marsha Schubert, Richard L. Schubert and Schubert and Associates (Defendants), pursuant to Section 1-603 of the Oklahoma Uniform Securities Act of 2004 (Act), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§1-101 through 1-701 (Supp. 2003). The Plaintiff also filed an application for an order freezing the Defendants' assets and for the appointment of a receiver. This Court appointed Douglas L. Jackson as receiver (Receiver).

On February 28, 2014, the *Affidavit of Douglas L. Jackson, Receiver Verifying Payment of Final Expenses and Distribution to Creditors* was filed with this Court.

On March 7, 2014, Plaintiff filed a *Motion to Dismiss and to Dissolve Receivership* (Motion).

This Court, having reviewed all pleadings and submissions of the parties, and there having been no objections to the Motion, finds that the goals for which the Receiver was appointed have been successfully achieved, the purposes for which the Receiver was appointed have been fulfilled, and the need for continued oversight by the Receiver is now at an end.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all the actions taken by the Receiver in this matter

were taken for the benefit of investors and other persons likely to have been injured by the investment activities of Marsha Schubert, individually, and doing business as Schubert and Associates, and are in accordance with the purposes for which the Receiver was appointed. This Court is satisfied that all payments made by the Receiver from the liquidation of Defendant's assets were legal and proper.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver has taken reasonable actions necessary to settle all outstanding claims against the Defendants.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver turn over all his books and records to the Oklahoma Department of Securities.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the rights, powers and duties of the Receiver previously established by this Court are terminated and the Receivership is hereby dissolved effective the date hereof and the Receiver shall have no further obligations in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all of the Receiver's actions in this receivership are hereby approved and the Receiver is hereby discharged.




