

ORDER APPOINTING HEARING OFFICER


WHEREAS, on January 23, 2006, the Administrator of the Oklahoma Department of Securities (Administrator) set a hearing in this matter at 10:00 a.m. on March 8, 2006.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1-602 of the Oklahoma Uniform Securities Act of 2004 (Act), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 1-101 through 1-701 (Supp. 2003), the Administrator may designate and appoint any person as hearing officer for the purpose of conducting any proceeding under the Act. Such section further provides that the hearing officer may administer oaths and affirmations, subpoena witnesses, compel their attendance, take evidence, and require the production of any records that the Administrator deems relevant or material to the proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Norwood Beveridge, of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, is designated and appointed as hearing officer to afford Respondent the opportunity to present evidence and argument as to whether or not an order should be issued based on the Enforcement Division Recommendation and to make a recommendation to the Administrator based upon the evidence and legal authority presented.


